

Utah Scooter Laws 41 -6a -1115

- Except as otherwise provided in this section, a motor assisted scooter is subject to the provisions under this chapter of a bicycle.
- A person under 8 years of age **may not** operate a motor-assisted scooter with the motor running on any public property, highway, path, or sidewalk.
- A person **may not** operate a motor-assisted scooter:
 - In a public parking structure.
 - On public property posted as an area prohibiting bicycles.
 - While carrying more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed.
 - That has been structurally or mechanically altered from the original manufacturer's design, except for an alteration by, or done at the request of, a person who rents the motor-assisted scooter to lower the maximum speed for the scooter; or
 - At a speed greater than 15 MPH or in violation of Subsection 41-6a-1115.1(3)

**E-Bikes, Scooters, Golf Carts,
& Mini Motorcycles**

Utah E-Bike Laws 41-6a-102

Age Restrictions:

- An individual under 16 years of age **may not** operate a Class 3 e-bike.
- An individual under 14 years old **may not** operate an electric-assisted bicycle with the electric motor engaged on any public property, highway, path, or sidewalk unless the individual is under the direct supervision of the individual's parent or guardian.
- An individual under 8 years old **may not** operate an electric-assisted bicycle with the electric motor engaged on any public property, highway, path, or sidewalk.

Utah E -Bike Classifications:

Class 1: Pedal assist e-bike with max speed of 20 MPH. The motor provides assistance when the rider is pedaling.

Class 2: Throttle assist e-bike with max speed of 20 MPH. The motor can be engaged without pedaling.

Class 3: Pedal assist e-bike with a max speed of 28 MPH. The motor only provides assistance when the rider is pedaling.



Utah Golf Cart Laws 41 -6a -1510 1(b)

A person **may not** operate a golf cart on a highway unless authorized by the municipality in which the highway is located. Bluffdale City has NOT authorized the use of golf carts (gas or electric), regardless of the age of the driver, on roadways within Bluffdale City.

Mini-Motorcycle Restrictions 41 -6a -1117

A person **may not** operate a mini-motorcycle on any public property, highway, path, or sidewalk unless:

- a. The mini -motorcycle is registered for highway use in accordance with Title 41, chapter 1a, Motor Vehicle Act and
- b. The operator is licensed to operate a motorcycle in accordance with Title 53, chapter 3, Uniform Drivers License Act



Helmet Requirements

E-Bikes, Scooters and Golf Carts: Helmets are required for riders under 18 years old.

Motorcycles: Helmets are required for riders under 21 years old.
