## MAYOR'S MESSAGE



In preparation for your invitation to Old West Days and Rodeo, I read about our City Town Days history. In the Neilson family history book titled

“One of a Kind”, I learned that in 1959, Ben Parry initiated it first Town Days!

“Ben suggested that the town designate one Saturday each summer to allow those living in town to visit with those who had moved, renewing old acquaintances. The mutual presidencies (youth leaders) organized the event. Originally, the day was simply a time to visit. Yet, as years passed, many activities were added including concessions, rides, a parade, a queen contest and breakfast sponsored by the Lions Club.”

Bluffdale was incorporated in 1978. The first flyer I could find was from 1981.

I learned that Town Days has had many names. It was called Rockwell Roundup starting in 1989. What a fun tribute to Porter Rockwell and our history! The Rodeo was also called the Rockwell Roundup Rodeo until 2001. Regardless of what our City Celebration has been called over the years, it is important to note that there have been thousands of volunteers and sponsors



over the past 66 years. There are so many people who have volunteered their time over the years, I can't list them all. Thank you to everyone past and present who have contributed their time and talents to bring us together.

Old West Days this year kicks off with our Badlands Run. This run first started in 1981. In 1986 it got the name of the Badlands Run. The run will be on Saturday, July 12th and all are invited to walk or run 5K or 10K. There will be medals and shirts!

Don't miss the Return of the Rodeo Celebration on July 17th. This event is free. There will be trick riders, mutton bustin', a horse breed show, a dirt dance with Chris Petersen Band and FIREWORKS! On July 18th and 19th is the rodeo - tickets are available

**PROPERTY TAXES**

No other state has a property tax system identical to Utah's (a few states have similar systems). Utah's property tax system uses a certified tax rate mechanism, where tax rates are adjusted annually to maintain stable revenue and prevent windfall increases for taxing entities (like counties, cities, and school districts) despite changes in property values.

When property values increase, the certified tax rate (%) decreases to keep the total tax revenue (\$) roughly constant, (excluding new growth). This means if there was never an increase in the rate by the entity, the revenue would be the same in 1978 as it is in 2025. The rate is unadjusted for inflation. Since Bluffdale's incorporation in 1978, the city has only adjusted its tax rate four times.

The new rate given to us for Salt Lake County for the next fiscal year is .000866. Note that since property values increased over last year, the tax rate has decreased from last year.

Notably, only 10% of the total property tax you pay goes to Bluffdale City and 100% of the Bluffdale portion goes to public safety. The percentage coming to Bluffdale has decreased every year because other entities have adjusted their rate to compensate for inflation and we have not.

**THE 2025-2026 BUDGET**

The City Council passed the 2025-2026 Budget in June. There will not be a tax increase in Bluffdale or the use of fund balance (savings account) with this year's budget. There are

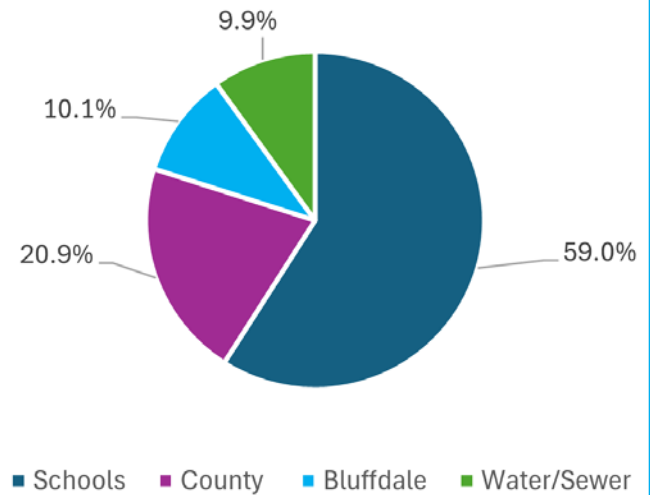


only 2 cities in Salt Lake County that have lower tax rates. Bluffdale's staff, the mayor and council all worked hard to provide a balanced and conservative budget. Thank you to the citizen Budget Review Committee for their feedback and work as well. **EFFICIENT USE OF RESOURCES**

Our city does an incredible job working with such a smaller budget compared to the other surrounding cities. We have been able to maintain our roads, add water tanks, update water lines, plow our roads, provide crossing guards, build a recreation program, maintain parks and so much more. Remember that your property taxes do not go toward any of these services. In fact, property taxes only cover 34% of fire and police services. Funding for these and other services must come from other revenue sources. We are continuing to grow economically, which has helped, and new development projects also add

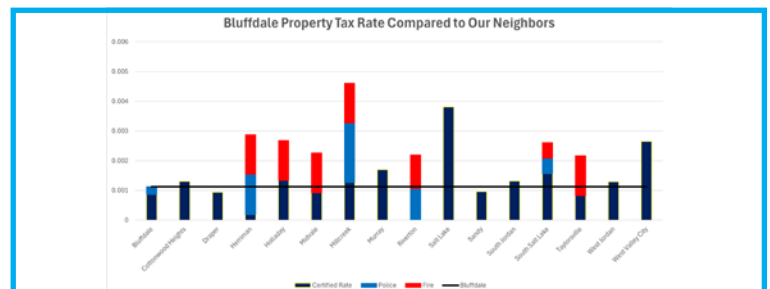
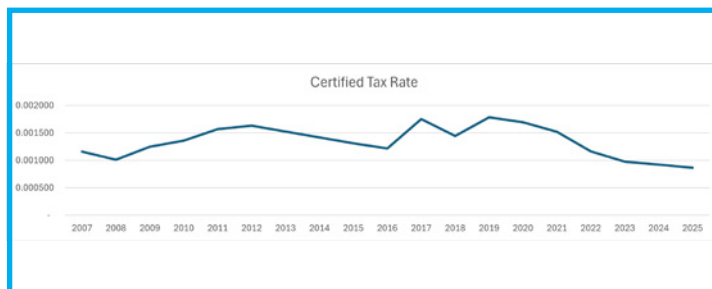
**Percentage of Total Property Taxes**



one-time money to the revenue.

Because we are limited in our funding, we regularly apply for various grant money. A federal grant will help us with a pedestrian bridge over the railroad to allow students to get to school. County grant money has allowed us to update our rodeo area. State funding has helped us with the one-way bridge project and so much more. In fact, 67% of the cost of our capitol projects is funded through grants and reimbursements. This money could be sent to other cities, and we are fortunate that we have been the recipients of the funding. It is largely due to the work of the mayor and staff being able to work closely with Federal, State and County representatives.



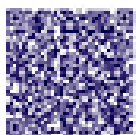
## BLUFFDALE'S FUTURE GROWTH PLAN

- safe as it grows.



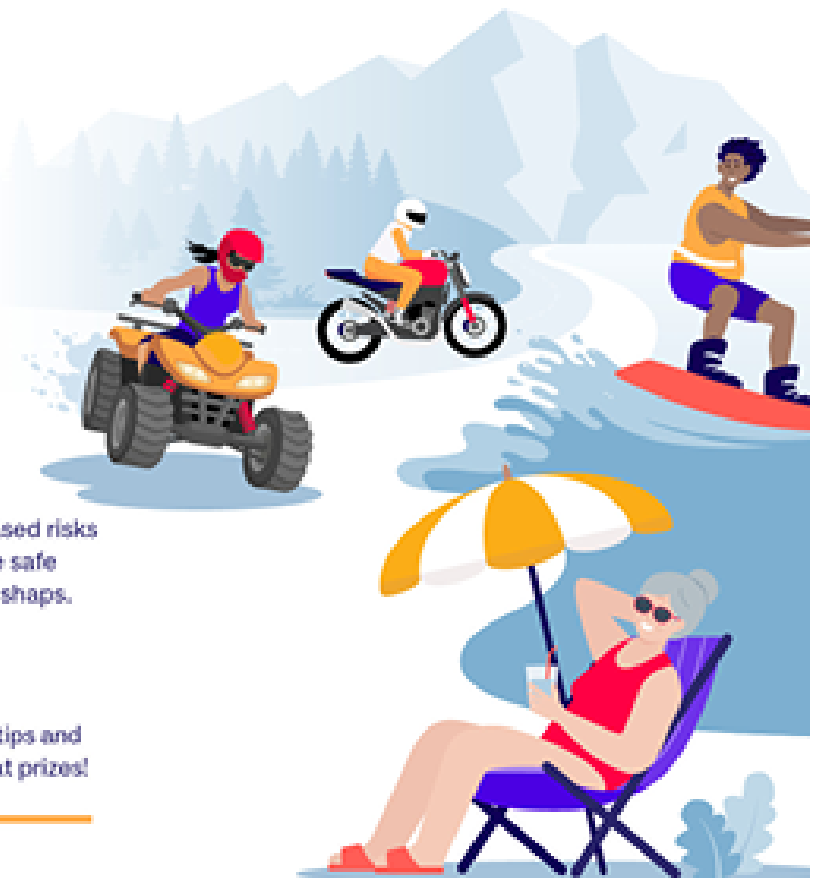

## TRANSPORTATION LAWS FOR E-BIKES, SCOOTERS, GOLF CARTS, AND MINI MOTORCYCLES

Bluffdale is clarifying local rules for motor-assisted scooters, e-bikes, mini-motorcycles, and golf carts to keep everyone safe. Here's what riders need to know:

### MOTOR-ASSISTED SCOOTERS

- Treated like bicycles under Bluffdale code.
- Riders under 8 are prohibited from operating them with the motor on public roads, paths, or sidewalks
- You may not ride in parking structures, "no bicycle" zones, nor carry extra passengers. Modifications that increase speed are forbidden unless done by the rental company to lower speed.
- Maximum allowed speed: 15 MPH.

### ELECTRIC-ASSIST BICYCLES (E-BIKES)

- Class 1: Pedal-assist, max 20 MPH
- Class 2: Throttle-assist, max 20 MPH

- Class 3: Pedal-assist, max 28 MPH
- Under-8 riders (or under-16 for Class 3) cannot use the motor on sidewalks or public paths; under-14 riders need adult supervision.

### MINI-MOTORCYCLES & GOLF CARTS

- Mini-motorcycles must be street-registered and operators licensed as motorcycle riders
- Golf carts aren't allowed on Bluffdale roads unless specifically approved by the city

### HELMET REQUIREMENTS

- Riders under 18 must wear helmets on e-bikes, scooters, and golf carts. Anyone under 21 riding a motorcycle also must wear a helmet

By following these guidelines, we can stay safer on Bluffdale's roads and pathways. For full details, review Bluffdale's Transportation Laws brochure or contact the Police Department at 801-798-5600.

## SALT LAKE COUNTY ANIMAL CONTROL LOBBY RENOVATION UNDERWAY

Construction is officially underway on a major renovation of our front lobby at Salt Lake County Animal Services. This exciting project reflects our continued commitment to creating a more welcoming and functional space for the public, adopters, and volunteers.

Among the key improvements is a newly designed Adoption Suite located near the front entrance. Our Adoption Team will be relocated from the auditorium to this bright and accessible space, making the adoption process easier and more inviting for our visitors.

Other updates include the conversion of the women's restroom into two private family restrooms, a new windowed station to improve lobby visibility and safety for our on-site officer, and a renovated Volunteer Suite with improved organization and workspace to better support our volunteers.

Construction is expected to continue through early fall. Services to the public remain open throughout the remodel. We're excited to see it all come together and look forward to

sharing the finished space with you once the project is complete.

These enhancements not only improve day-to-day operations but also strengthen our ability to serve the community and continue advancing our no-kill mission—ensuring every pet has a chance at a loving home.
